

The City of Saskatoon offers \$20 rebates to city residents who purchase a rain barrel and/or compost bin. Households are eligible for one rebate per new item per year. Institutions, schools, community gardens and businesses are also eligible as long as the items are used for educational purposes. Rebates are administered by the Saskatchewan Waste Reduction Council (SWRC).

Rebate options include:

1. Purchasing a rain barrel or compost bin from a local retailer. Submissions must include a copy of the receipt from a licensed business.
2. Purchasing materials to build your own compost bin or rain barrel. Submissions must include a copy of the receipt from a licensed business, a photo of the supplies, and a photo of the finished rain barrel and/or compost bin.

(A licensed business is any store or company with a business license.)

PLEASE NOTE: This rebate does *not* apply to kitchen compost pails or subscriptions to the green cart program.
