  - Started in 1997
  - Operated by SARRC
- Products
  - Used Oil, Oil filters, Oil containers
  - Used Antifreeze, Diesel Exhaust Fluid (DEF), diesel fuel filters and their associated containers
- Updates
  - Addition of materials

  - New fee schedule

- Products
  - Paper and Packaging
- Updates
  - PMP approved December 2013
  - Program implementation January 1, 2015
