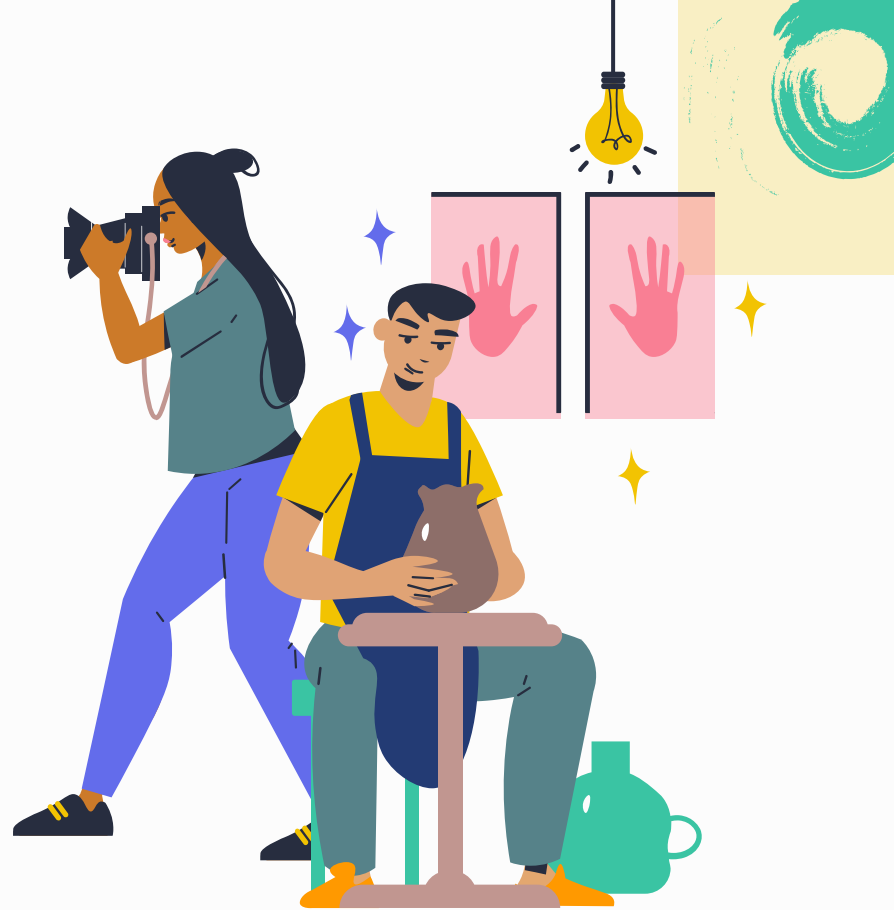

WHAT IS SASKATOON MAKERSPACE?

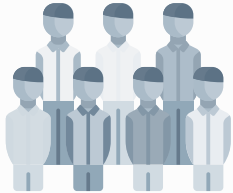

The space itself is filled with a variety of different artists in various mediums that all have the same goal of creation and expression, leading to collaboration and learning amongst artists.



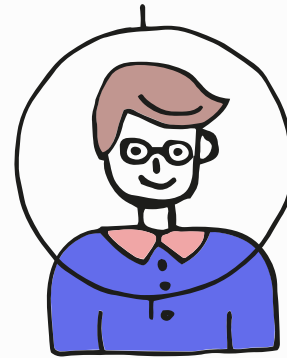
