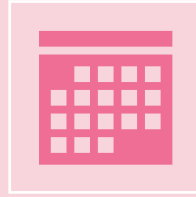

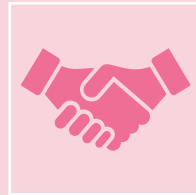

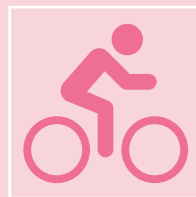
Some Background Context



Program began in November of 2016



Program delivered in partnership with the City of Saskatoon



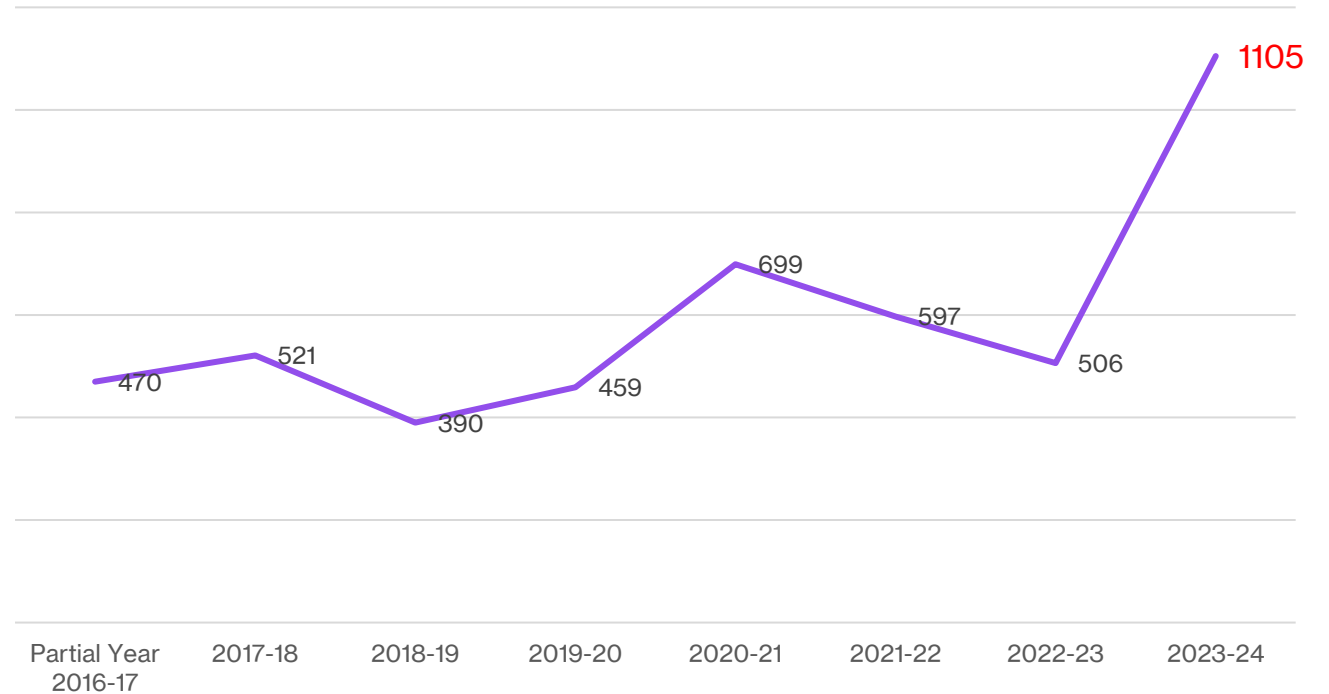
Goal: find ways to remove perfectly re-usable bicycles from the Saskatoon Landfill



Some statistics

- Since November of 2016, this program has received 4,747 bicycles
- Of those:
 - 2,400 bicycles have been diverted in full
 - 1,046 bicycles have been diverted in part
 - **72.5% diversion rate**
- The recent opening of the Material Recovery Centre has led to a 110% increase in bicycles received
