Eco-Action Community Funding Program

- The CSLP applied for funding to start a community composting program in Craik in July of 2009
- The grant helped with the cost of pails, compostable bags, signs, advertising, and salary for project coordinators.
- The grant required matching contributions with equal funding, which in our case is in-kind donations from partners.

Program set-up:

- Visited168 homes in Craik twice
- 85% said they would try
- 11% said no

CSLP encouraged people to participate through advertising and word of mouth.

Acceptable Items:

- •ALL food items (including meat, cheese, bones)
- House plants, including soil
- Diaper and other sanitary products
- Pet food, animal waste and bedding, kitty litter
- Paper towels, tissues, napkins, flour/sugar bags, meat paper, ice cream boxes, fast food paper packaging, paper plates

- -Reduces waste landfills
