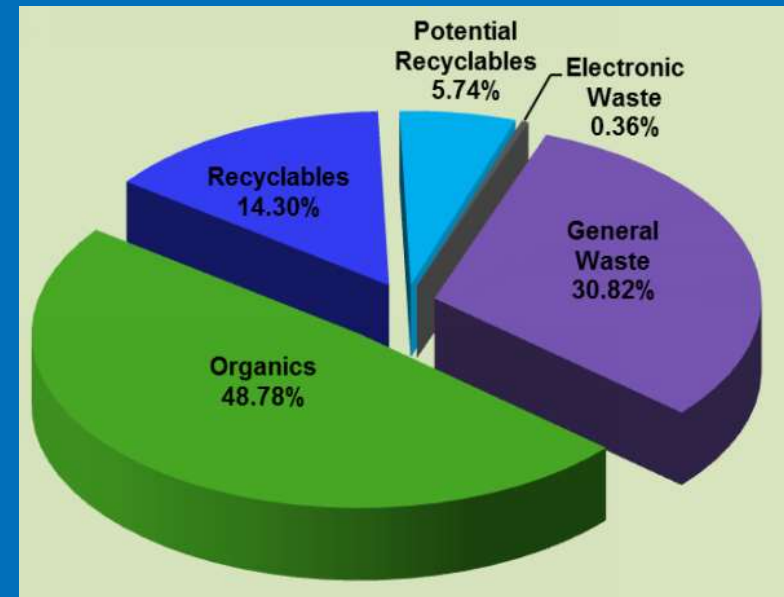

- Pilot Testing
 - 24 weeks
 - 254 households
 - 90% participation rate
 - 55 tonnes diverted

- Program was launched in April 1, 2013

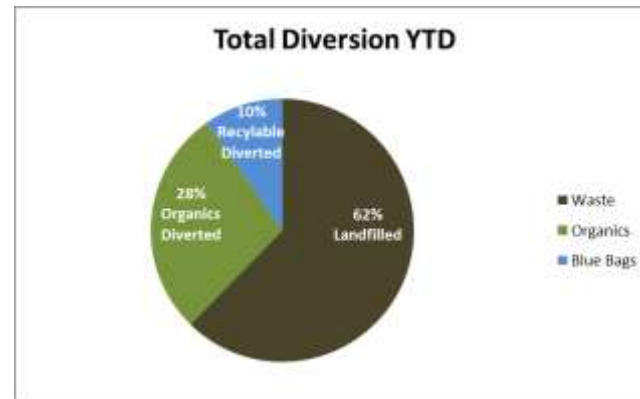
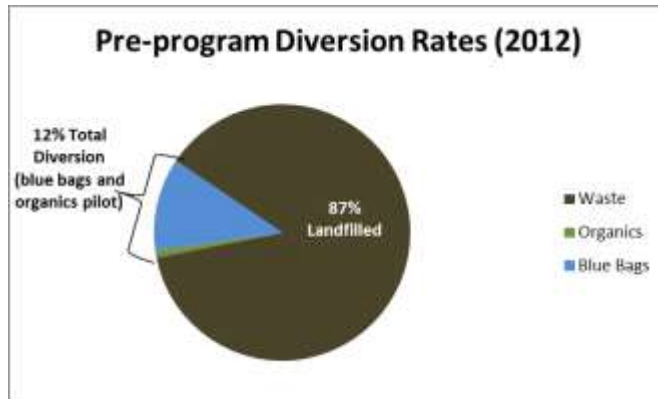
